


HIPAA PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES FOR MINORS EXCEPTIONS IN WV IN THE PROVIDER SCENARIO

The individual is under 18 years of age and the PHI involved is one of the following treatment areas: VD, alcohol or controlled substance addiction, blood donation, HIV/AIDS, or birth control, or the individual is a mature minor*.



*A "mature minor" is defined as "a person less than eighteen years of age who has been determined by a qualified physician or a qualified psychologist or an advanced nurse practitioner to have the capacity to make health care decisions." WV Code §16-30-3(o)

NOTE: In emergency circumstances, a provider is permitted to treat without consent or authorization.

**Obtain documentation where it is determined that an individual can serve as a HIPAA personal representative.
